

### **DAY 2: Arrive Delhi**

Wednesday, 12 November 2025

On arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check in. Enjoy the remainder of your day at leisure. Check in is from 12.00.

As the capital of India, Delhi is the third largest city with a population of approximately 18 million. Its strategic location along the north-south, east-west route has given it a focal position in Indian history and many great empires have been ruled from here. The monuments and ruins of these are scattered throughout the city, often cheek by jowl with modern structures and high-rise towers.

### DAY 3: Delhi

Thursday, 13 November 2025



After breakfast, you will be met at your hotel lobby for a full day of sightseeing with your guide. Start off your day in Old Delhi where you will view the Red Fort from outside before walking through Chandni Chowk, savouring the ambience of the oriental, crowded bazaar. Continue to India's largest mosque, Jama Masjid, built in 1656 AD. Marvel at the magnificent architecture made up of three domes, three large gates, two 40 metre high minarets made of sandstone and marble and a courtyard that can hold up to 26,000 people.

Head to Gandhi Smriti, where Gandhi was assassinated.

Stop by India Gate, a memorial to the Indian servicemen who died in World War I. Continue to Humayun's Tomb (the second Mughal Emperor) built in the mid-16th-century. This tomb is the first great example of a Mughal garden tomb and was the inspiration for several monuments such as the incomparable Taj Mahal.

End your day with a visit to the always busy and jam-packed Connaught Markets, where you can find linen, clothing, saris, handicrafts, jewellery, books, home wares and everything in between.

## DAY 4: Delhi - Shimla

Friday, 14 November 2025

This morning you will be met and driven to Delhi station, ready to board the train to Chandigarh. From there, you will be met and driven to Shimla.



On arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel for check-in.

Shimla is at an altitude of approx. 2,130, and is a charming resort town and the most loved hill station in India since British troops set up camp here in 1819. The construction of the train line from Kalka to Shimla was built in 1903, allowing for easy access to the region. Surrounded by pine forests, oak trees and rhododendrons it is the perfect place to escape the heat of the lowlands.

This afternoon, take a short hike up the Jakhoo hill to visit the Jakhu Temple. It is the highest point in Shimla and offers a panoramic view of the quaint town. Enjoy the evening at leisure to walk around the Mall Road.

### **DAY 5: Shimla**

Saturday, 15 November 2025

Enjoy a 2 hour miniature gauges 'Toy Train' starting from Shimla at 10:30am. This historic rail route has 105 tunnels with single and double arches. The train will stop at Kandhagath at 12:30pm where you will be met and transferred back to the city.

Visit the **Vice Regal Lodge**, located on the Observatory Hill, also known as the 'Rashtrapati Niwas.' It is surrounded by well-maintained gardens and lawns, the lodge has now been converted into the Institute of Advanced Study. Head to the Christ Church, one of Shimla's Major landmarks and is the second oldest church in Northern India.





Continue to visit the Scandal Point, named after the flirtatious Prince of Patiala who is said to have eloped with the daughter of the British Viceroy.

You will visit the Himalayan Aviary, a natural habitat for numerous species of birds including the national bird of India, the Peacock.

# **DAY 6: Shimla - Udaipur**

Sunday, 16 November 2025

Today, you will be met in your hotel lobby and transferred to Chandigarh airport, ready to board your flight to Delhi, with onward connecting flight to Udaipur.



Today, the City Palace of Udaipur is still home to Maharaja Udai Singh's descendants who remain rulers of this independent state.



# **DAY 7: Udaipur**

Monday, 17 November 2025



In the morning, enjoy a drive around Fateh Sagar Lake, which has a garden café on its island. Located nearby are the Folk Museum and Mewar Art Gallery. Although the Folk Museum is small and has been neglected a bit over the years, the unique variety of ethnic groups and cultures of the hills around Udaipur make this visit well worthwhile. Also visit the Sahelion Ki Bari Garden (Garden for the Maids of Honour). This delightful 18th-century retreat in the north of the city was built for the Queen of Udaipur, whose dowry included 48 maids.

Visit the massive City Palace which overlooks Lake Pichola. The City Palace, built in 1725, comprises of 11 palaces, all of which are ornately decorated. You will then walk down the street leading from the gates of the palace to your bus where you will have the opportunity to shop in the local stalls along the way.

Also enjoy a cruise on the 4km long Lake Pichola, fringed with hills, palaces, havelis, ghats and temples. Whilst on the cruise you will see the Lake Palace.



It was once a royal summer retreat and is now one of the world's greatest hotels. It is also a popular location for film shoots, including James Bond's Octopussy.

# DAY 8:Udaipur - Jaipur

Tuesday, 18 November 2025

Today you will be met and driven to Jaipur.

On arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel for check in. Enjoy the remainder of your day at leisure.

Jaipur was founded in 1727 as Mughal power within India was declining. The city is now the capital of Rajasthan State and commonly called the 'Pink City' because of the pink paint on all the buildings in the old city area. This was apparently done to imitate the magnificent, red sandstone buildings of the Mughals and in an attempt to impress the Prince of Wales when he visited Jaipur in 1876.

# **DAY 9: Jaipur**

Wednesday, 19 November 2025



You will start with a brief photo stop at the Hawa Mahal (Palace of the Winds). This is a five-story palace, which was erected in 1799 by the Sawai Pratap Singh so that the veiled ladies of his harem could observe, unnoticed, the lively street scenes below.

You will continue to visit the Amer Fort. After you arrive at the base of Amer Fort, you will take a Jeep ride that will take you all the way up to the entrance. Built from yellow and pink sandstone and white marble, you will explore the inside of the fort including visits to the Jag Mandir or the Hall of Victory, which houses the famed Sheesh Mahal.

This afternoon, you will visit the City Palace to explore the former Royal residence. Outside the gate to the Maharaja's City Palace is Jantar Mantar Observatory, the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world. The observatory has 17 large instruments, many of them still in working condition.

Before returning to the hotel, you will stop for some shopping inside the walled city, where villagers from around Jaipur come to sell and trade their produce. The rest of the evening is free at your leisure.

# DAY 10: Jaipur - Ranthambhore

Thursday, 20 November 2025

Today you will be met and driven to Ranthambhore.



On arrival, check in to your hotel. Enjoy the remainder of your day at leisure.

The forest around Ranthambhore was once the private hunting grounds of the Maharajas of Jaipur and is one of the largest national parks in Northern India. Ranthambhore National Park is renowned for its tiger population; however, you may also come across other wild animals such as leopard, nilgai, wild boar, sambar, hyena and sloth bears.

### **DAY 11: Ranthambhore**

Friday, 21 November 2025

Tigers are synonymous with India and the opportunity to observe one in the wild is often a highlight of any holiday in the country.

Start your exploration of the park by joining a shared morning and afternoon safari to catch a glimpse of these beautiful wild animals.

**Please note:** Photo ID is required when visiting the Park. Please ensure you bring your passport to gain entry.





# DAY 12: Ranthambhore - Agra

Saturday, 22 November 2025

This morning you will be met and driven to Agra.



En route, you will visit Fatehpur Sikri. Located 40km from Agra, Fatehpur Sikri was built by Emperor Akbar in 1569 after it was prophesised that the then childless Akbar would have sons if he moved his capital to the site. At great expense to the empire, the capital was moved here but sadly only occupied for 14 years before slowly being deserted and ruined after Akbar left the city due to a scarcity of water. Whilst here you visit the remarkably well-preserved and graceful buildings within the Ghost City including the Jama Masjid, tomb of Salim Chisti, Panch Mahal Palace and other palaces that speak of the grandeur and splendour of the Mughal Empire at the height of its power.

Continue to Agra.

On arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel for check in.

The magical allure of the Taj Mahal draws tourists to Agra like moths to a wondrous flame. And despite the hype, it's every bit as good as you've heard. But the Taj is not a stand-alone attraction. The legacy of the Mughal empire has left a magnificent fort and a liberal sprinkling of fascinating tombs and mausoleums; and there's also fun to be had in the bustling markets.



Situated on the West bank of the Yamuna River is the Agra Fort. You will visit this walled compound with your local guide, founded in the 16th century by Emperor Akbar the Great. However, it was during the rule of Shah Jahan that fort took its current form with the construction of two beautiful white marble mosques.

# DAY 13: Agra - Delhi

Sunday, 23 November 2025



The most iconic sight in India is surely the Taj Mahal and it is for this reason that most people visit Agra.

Rise early to head to the site with your local guide. Experience the Taj Mahal at sunrise to see the gentle light reflecting on the white marble walls making the building glow. Shah Jahan built this mausoleum in memory of his wife Mumtaz and it is a monument to love. Note: For admission to the main mausoleum area you are required to wear shoe covers.

You will return to your hotel for breakfast and to freshen up. You will, later, visit a marble inlay workshop and learn about the intricate skill of laying marble, similar to what you would have seen at the Taj Mahal in the morning.

Later you will be met and driven to Delhi.

Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

On arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel for check in. Prepare for your evening tour.

Varanasi is a historical city in northern India and is sacred to Hindus and Jains and also one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world, with settlements dating back to the 11th century BC. The scene of pilgrims doing their devotions in the River Ganga at sunrise set against the backdrop of the centuries old temples is probably one of the most impressive sights in the world.

This evening, you will take a rickshaw ride through the streets of Varanasi, to the Ghats of the River Ganges to witness the Pooja ceremony of Ganga Aarti.

### **DAY 15: Varanasi**


Tuesday, 25 November 2025



Early in the morning, enjoy a boat ride on the River Ganges to view the Ghats at sunrise. The most important facet of this holy city is the river and the ghats lining its southern bank in the city. From dawn to dusk, the ghats are thronged by thousands of devotees, who perform their holy rituals in the hope of attaining salvation, the Nirvana.

Later this morning we commence on a brief sightseeing tour of Varanasi. We start by visiting some of the important temples like Bharat Mata Mandir, a unique temple inaugurated by Mahatma Gandhi, which interestingly houses one of the most perfect relief maps of India and is dedicated to Mother India. Another is Durga Temple dedicated to Goddess Durga, consort of Lord Shiva.

Later, you will visit Sarnath where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon. A major Buddhist centre, Sarnath lies 10 kilometres north east of Varanasi. Most of Sarnath's monuments are set in large gardens making it a picturesque place to spend time here.

### **Your Itinerary**

Your itinerary is designed specifically to meet your requirements. If it doesn't, please let us know so that we can amend it. If you would like to make a change then please let us know as soon as possible so we may minimize the cost to you.

Unless requested otherwise, your itinerary will operate at a moderate pace that is generally suitable for most travelers. If you require an itinerary that is particularly condensed or has a more relaxed pace please let us know so we may design your itinerary in an appropriate way.

### **Daily Touring**

Your daily touring will follow the itinerary described. Changes in the order and timing of touring may occur due to local conditions to ensure that your holiday runs smoothly.

This is a privately guided tour and you have flexibility in the timing and pace of your sightseeing. Please inform your guide if there are any parts of your itinerary where you wish to a take longer time and any parts where you would like a faster visit. Your guide will advise how you may adjust timings to fit within your overall itinerary. Please also inform your guide if you wish to pause at any point (for example to take photographs or to take a rest) or if you wish to return early to your hotel. These requests will be accommodated wherever it is practical to do so. If you wish to have a particularly condensed or relaxed itinerary throughout please let us know at the time of booking.

It is generally not possible to change your itinerary once your travel has commenced; however if this does occur you will need to pay for the additional services requested. The cost of any touring not taken will not be refunded.

### **Local Flights**

In general each traveler in economy class is limited to 20kgs of checked luggage and one piece of cabin baggage. Each piece of cabin baggage is usually limited to a maximum weight of 5kgs and dimensions of about 55 x 40 x 20 centimeters. Allowances may vary by airline. Please note that baggage weight restrictions are strictly enforced for reasons of safety as well as the physical capacity of the aircraft. If your luggage is overweight or oversized, you may incur considerable extra costs and your bags can be delayed as they may not travel with you.

Flights may be subject to overbooking, cancellation and schedule changes. If this occurs, Wendy Wu Tours will do all in their power to assist you in boarding flights or finding alternative arrangements. This is done as a courtesy to you and Wendy Wu Tours cannot be held responsible for denied boarding, nor for the additional costs incurred.



#### **Dinner Reservations**

### **Gratuities**

Tipping is not included in the cost of your tour. In most countries tipping is a customary part of the travel industry and across Asia this is no exception. The amount of gratuity is discretionary; however we would suggest an appropriate amount to be around £5 - 10 per traveler per day. This should be given to your guide before you depart each destination and this will be shared with your driver. Bellboys in hotels should be tipped about £1. High-end restaurants may expect a tip of 10% but local restaurants will expect less; however review your bill as a service charge may already be applied.

#### **Travel Guide**

A travel guide is supplied as part of your departure documentation. This is a generic guide which covers group as well as private travel; however much of the information is still relevant to your itinerary. Please read this guide as it contains some important information. It will allow you to better appreciate the nature of travel in Asia and will help you to maximize the enjoyment of your tour.
